2024 ACHIEVEMENTS

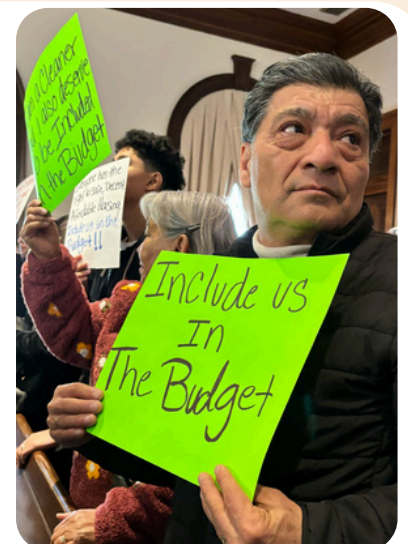


- \$10 million for a newly created Housing Trust Fund in Prince William County
- \$3 million for pipeline affordable housing projects in Alexandria City
- Additional funding for school-based mental health and college & career readiness staff in Alexandria City Public Schools (ACPS)
- \$500,000 in additional funding for the ARISE guaranteed income program in Alexandria City
- Additional commitments from Fairfax County to improve mobile home conditions and implement support programs
- Bringing the “Air Conditioning for Extreme Heat Resilience Pilot Program” to mobile home communities amid dangerously high summer temperatures
- Over 100 community members mobilized to Richmond in coalition with other orgs to make state level progress toward securing solutions to the housing crisis and advancing tenants’ rights, workers’ rights, education justice, and more


2025 GOALS

Centering civic education, leadership development, and power-building with low-income communities of color, we aim to win local and state level changes that:


- support immigrants’ rights
- preserve mobile home communities
- expand deeply affordable and dignified housing
- improve educational outcomes for youth of color
- advance health equity
- fund programs to support our families, including local housing vouchers, guaranteed basic income, & more
